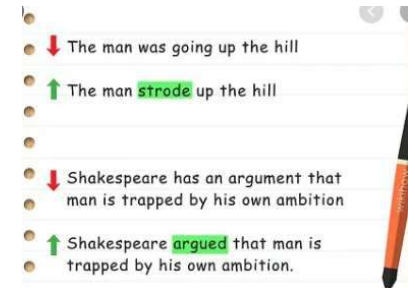
This year has been so special,

Just being who you are!



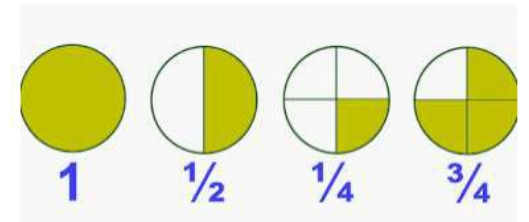
English

Daily tasks

Spelling: Your own spelling words. Go back through all the comments your teachers have given you on Seesaw and write down all the spellings they have asked you to learn or check. Do you know them all? Use one of the spelling strategies we have tried this year, like pyramid spelling, vowels in different colours, or word pictures to practise your words and then ask your adult to test you.

Handwriting: Find one of your favourite books and use your best, joined handwriting to copy out the blurb on the back.

Reading: 20 minutes daily reading. Ask and respond to questions about the text that you are reading.

Times tables: Log in to Times Table Rockstars and keep practising on sound check for rapid recall of times tables. Focus on your 8s and 9s. Extra Mild: 3s and 5s.

Mymaths: Log in to mymaths and work through tasks provided.

Bugclub: Log in to BugClub and read through books that have been set. Answer any questions given.
