To make these eco-friendly, we used old buttons from Miss Wilkinson's sewing box, recycled paper string and a thick twig from the forest school.

First, we cut the string into long pieces and tied this to the twig. Then we carefully fed the string through the buttonholes. This means that when the wind blows, the buttons will hit each other and make a soft, pleasant sound for you to hear.

The children who made it have decided to hang it up in the forest school, so keep an eye out for it when your class visits. If you fancy making one at home, I would love to see what you used and where you choose to put it. Have fun!
