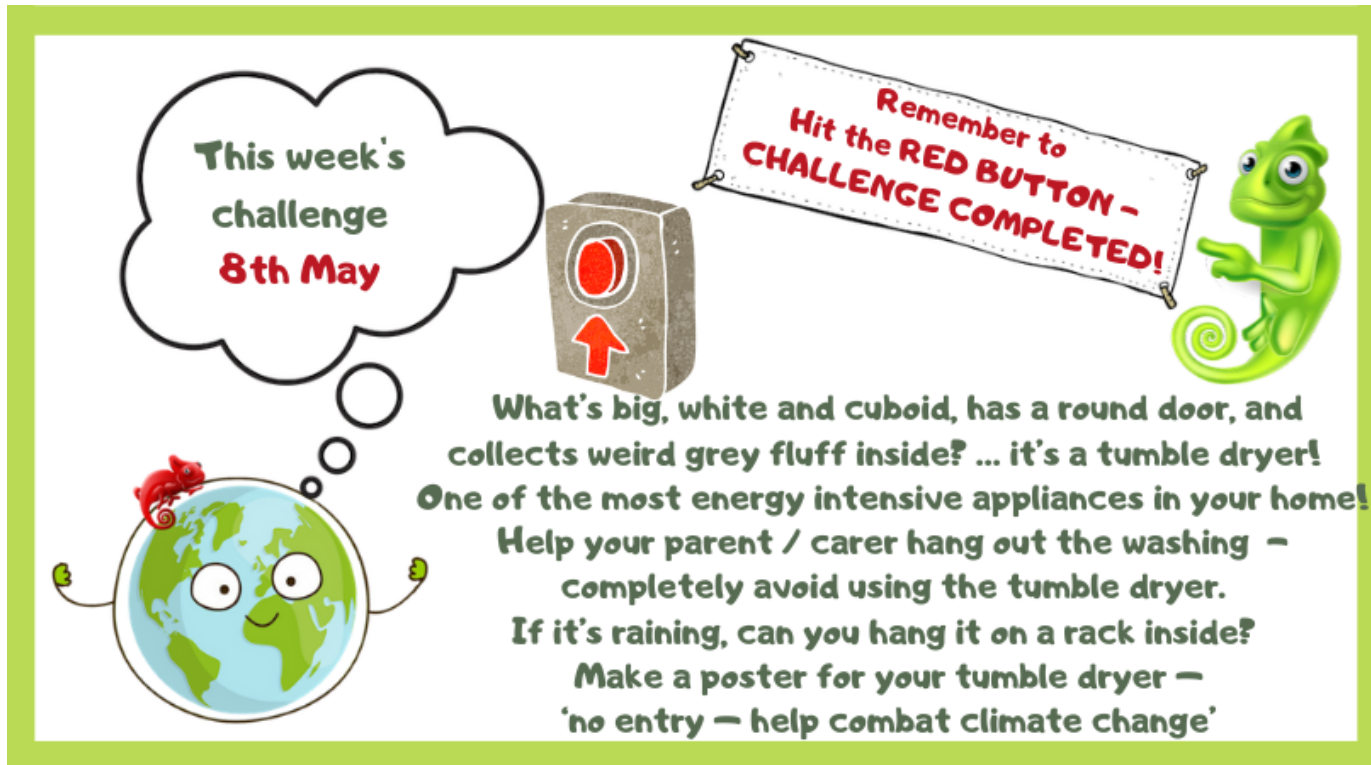




Nearly three-quarters of the carbon footprint of a load of laundry comes from drying rather than washing. So give the tumble dryer a rest!

If every household in the UK reduced their tumble dryer usage by 2 sessions per week for a year, we would reduce our carbon emissions by 1.8million tonnes.
