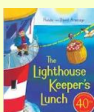


ENGLISH

Mental health

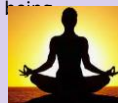
- understand big feelings and how to manage them

Place value and

As mathematicians, we are learning about:

Place Value

- recognising tens and ones
- use place value charts
- partition numbers to 100 (flexibly)
- write numbers to 100
- estimate on a number line
- compare objects and numbers
- count in 2 and 3s

Addition and Subtraction

- number bonds to 10 and 20
- related facts and fact families
- number bonds to 100
- adding three 1-digit numbers
- add and subtract across a ten
- add 2-digit numbers (crossing ten)
- subtract 2-digit numbers (crossing ten)
- compare number sentences

SCIENCE

We are looking at: Living things and their habitats

As scientists, we are learning about:
