- Using prepositions to express time, cause and place like **above, beside, until**
- Applying different sentence structures

- Using subordinate clauses to create complex sentences
- Use the present perfect form of verbs.

SCIENCE

We are looking at **Plants**

- Investigating how water is transported within plants
- Exploring the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants.

- Our key Scientist-Gregor Mendel who investigated plant genetics and how living things pass characteristics to offspring
