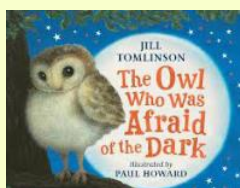


ENGLISH

MUSIC

We are looking at pitch and percussion instruments.

As musicians we are learning to:

- To read and write dot notation when performing using xylophones, boom whackers and other classroom instruments.
- Develop our knowledge of sign and sound using Solfege.
- Understand pitch can be linked to size of instrument chime bar sizes = high low.
- Understand pitch on notated music = high / low on staff / steps on staff relate to note steps.
- Gain awareness of dot notation, using single line and then staves to notate do, re, me, fa so.

We are looking at sewing. This will be based on the book 'The Way Back Home'

As artists, we are learning to:

- Develop and practise sewing skills.
- Design a hand puppet after research
- Evaluate a finished product against design criteria.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION

We are looking at space dance in indoor PE.

As dancers, we are learning to:

- move in time to the beat

- dance in time to the music with varying levels
- perform dance movements to travel

MATHS

We are looking at money and multiplication and division.

As mathematicians, we are learning:

Money:

- how to solve two step problems.

Multiplication and division:

- to recognise, make and add equal groups
- the two times table
- dividing by two
- doubling and halving
- the ten times table
- dividing by ten
- the five times table
- dividing by five



SCIENCE

We are looking at materials.

As scientists, we are learning about:

Materials

- explore and identify different types of materials including plastic, rubber, wood, metal and glass
- investigate how materials are matched to their purpose
- understand suitability of materials
- explore how different materials change shape
