We are looking at narratives and newspaper reports.

As readers and writers, we are learning about:

- the structure of a narrative
- writing a narrative based on 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna
- the structure of a newspaper report
- writing a newspaper report about a classic fairy tale.

We are reading 'The Boy at the Back of the Class'.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We are looking at 'Dialogue and Encounter'.

As spiritual people, we are learning about:

- the Bible and the importance of the Church in helping people encounter the meaning of the text, beyond what is written
- how the Bible is not one large volume of text but a collection of different writings gathered over time
- how the authors within the Bible have been inspired by the Holy Spirit
- texts that Christians refer to as the Old Testament are books of the Jewish religion
- the importance of Hebrew as the holy language for Jewish people and understanding how prayer, beliefs and sacred objects form part of Jewish life.

COMPUTING

We are looking at vector drawing. As digital experts, we are learning about:

- selecting, using and combining software on digital devices
- designing and creating a range of programs, systems and content that accomplish given goals, for example, collecting, analysing, evaluating, and presenting data and information.

We are looking at collage totem animal masks.

As artists, we are learning about:

- cutting a range of materials with precision and accuracy
- producing annotated sketches to develop and communicate ideas
- making a totem mask that is appealing.



GEOGRAPHY

We are looking at Ghana.

As geographers, we are learning about:

- where cocoa producing countries are located
- the location and geographical features of Ghana
- everyday life for cocoa farmers
- problems faced by cocoa farmers
- how FairTrade supports cocoa farmers.



FRENCH



We are looking at shopping and prices in France.

As linguists, we are learning about:

- building numbers and prices confidently in French
- naming different foods
- joining in with and performing a short story
- vocabulary to describe a quantity
- exploring and understanding an authentic French text
- changes in sound caused by accents when speaking, especially acute accent é, grave accent è and ç cedilla
- changes in voice intonation to indicate when a question is being asked.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

We are looking at cricket and OAA (Outdoor adventurous activity).

As athletes, we are learning about:

- different fielding techniques to stop the ball
- throwing and catching a ball over a variety of distances
- bowling using an underarm and overarm throwing technique
- how we can hit the ball with control over a variety of distances
- the map symbols used in orienteering
- how to follow directions using 8 compass points.

MATHS

We are learning about decimals, negative numbers, converting measures and volume.

As mathematicians, we are learning about:

- adding and subtracting decimal numbers with up to 3 decimal places
- multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 1000
- counting through zero and understanding negative numbers
- converting units of length, mass and time
- converting between metric and imperial units
- calculating with timetables
- understanding cubic centimetres
- comparing and estimating volume
- understanding and estimating capacity.

SCIENCE

We are looking at Earth Science.

As scientists, we are learning about:

- the impact of tourism on our environment
- climate debt and climate justice
- the impact of climate change in the Maldives
- permaculture methods and why they are important
- the future of our planet with and without climate change.

RSHE

We are looking at Life to the Full, Disability and Equality Education, Inclusion and Belonging, Online Safety and First Aid.

As children of God, we are learning about:

- physical changes that occur in puberty
- gender stereotypes and gender equality
- how to challenge stereotypes
- exploring what to share online
- basic first aid.

MUSIC

We are learning to record a song using GarageBand.

As musicians we are learning about:

- using samples and programming our own sounds
- following a chord sequence and song structure
- understanding and recording a drum beat
- recording our own singing voices.
