Lent and the Sacrament of Confession

This week, as part of our Lenten prayer and reflection, we offered the Sacrament of Reconciliation to children in Years 5 and 6. This was an opportunity for children to talk and say sorry for any wrongdoings and experience God's forgiveness. Thank you to Canon David who spent time talking to those who wished to attend about how we can always say sorry and how God always forgives.



Faith in Action

As you know, our 'Faith in Action' group arranged for children to participate in the Big Lent Walk as part of a fund-raising event for CAFOD. The aim was to support efforts to bring clean water to places like Ethiopia by walking 200km in 40 days. Children are invited to bring donations and ether will be collection buckets on the school gates on Monday. £12 can train one farmer to care for young seedlings. £94 can pay for a community seed bank. £231 can pay for enough floating gardens for a farmer to feed their family for a whole year. Children in KS1 and Year 3 walked to Newman Chapel and making a mini-pilgrimage to their Grotto, while children in Years 4 - 6 walked to St Peter's Church and back. This also took on the form of a pilgrimage during which the children visited the diocesan shrine of St Carlo Acutis which is housed in the church.

Report by the Year 6 Faith in Action group -

We recently took part in the Big Lent Walk, and made a mini-pilgrimage to St Peter's Church in Portland Road to raise money for CAFOD, who are supporting countries like Ethiopia by helping to bring them clean water. When we arrived at St Peter's, Fr David gave us a talk about what we could see in the church and showed us the Shrine of St Carlo Acutis. We were really fortunate at the end, as Fr David showed us the relic of St Carlo – a real piece of his hair! As a thank you to Fr David, Amelia, from the Faith in Action group, had written a special prayer for St Peter's Church which she read out beautifully. Our time finished with some refreshments in the Link and then we had to get back to school for the end of the day. We were really pleased to be the first year group to do the Big Lent Walk this year. We can't wait to see how much we will have raised for CAFOD!



Year 4 St Cuthman Forest School

Year 4 St Cuthman had a amazing morning at forest school recently. Children made some delicious toast over the fire, created some imaginative forts as well as making Nordic bracelets out of string. The class enjoyed the range of activities and worked really well together building, creating and enjoying the Spring sunshine.



Year 3 Pedestrian Training

Year 3 have been taking part in pedestrian training. They have been learning how to cross roads safely, rules of the road, how to safely navigate driveways and how to be a considerate pedestrian. The trainers, from Brighton and Hove Council, shared top tips and important safety information. For example, if your child is under 135cm tall, they must still use a car seat or booster whilst travelling in the car.
