

ENGLISH

We are looking at fiction, poetry and information writing. We will be reading 'We're Going on A Bear Hunt' and 'Ruby's Worry'.

As readers and writers, we are learning about:

- forming letters correctly including lower case and upper case letters
- writing simple sentences including finger spaces and full stops
- saying our sentence out loud before writing it down
- using phonics to sound out words
- using capital letters at the beginning of a sentence
- using adjectives to describe objects.



COMPUTING

We are getting to know Seesaw, our learning platform. We will explore the tools available and understand how each one can be useful to our learning

As digital experts, we are:

- using technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.



ART and D.T.

We are looking at mark-making and experimenting in our drawings.

As artists, we are:

- learning that drawing is a physical and emotional activity
- learning that when we draw, we can move our whole body
- learning that we can control the lines we make by being aware of how we hold a drawing tool, how much pressure we apply, and how fast or slow we move.

HISTORY

We are looking at Guy Fawkes and Bonfire Night.

As historians, we are learning about:

- Bonfire Night in the past
- the Gunpowder Plot
- Guy Fawkes
- different sources of evidence
- how Bonfire Night has changed since our grandparents were young.

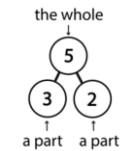


MATHS

We are looking at Place Value within 10.

As mathematicians, we are learning about:

- sorting, counting and representing objects
- counting, reading and writing numbers forwards and backwards
- finding one more and one less
- using symbols $<$ $>$ $=$
- using a number line from 0-10
- using a part whole model
- forming numbers correctly
- adding and subtracting single digit numbers.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We are looking at Creation and Covenant, looking at the Creation story and the Catholic Creed.

As spiritual people, we are learning about:

- the story of how God made the world
- how everything comes from God
- how God shows His love for us through creation
- how we can draw closer to God through prayer
- how we should care for God's world
- how people care for God's world.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION

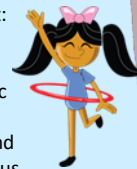
We are looking at gymnastics and ball skills.

As athletes, we are learning about:

- mastering basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching.
- developing balance, agility and co-ordination.

As gymnasts we are learning about:

- balancing and controlling our bodies
- performing different gymnastic shapes
- performing balances, jumps and shapes using different apparatus.



RSHE

We are looking at New Beginnings, Mental Health and Wellbeing, Families, Respect and Tolerance and Online Safety.

As children of God, we are learning about:

- how we are all unique and have different gifts and talents
- identify how Britain celebrates difference and shows respect and tolerance to all
- people who are special to us
- recognising and describing feelings
- understanding that the internet connects us to others (online safety)
- understand what racism is and how to challenge it safely.

SCIENCE

We are looking at animals including humans, and seasonal change.

As scientists, we are learning about:

- parts of the body and their uses
- the five senses
- classifying animals into groups, including reptiles, mammals, birds, fish and amphibians
- vertebrates and invertebrates
- the four seasons
- types of weather
- types of clouds.
