As readers and writers, we are learning about:

- holding a pencil correctly
- using pre-cursive handwriting
- lower case and capital letters
- finger spaces and full stops
- using adjectives in simple sentences.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We are looking at The First Christmas.

As spiritual people, we are learning about:

- the Annunciation – when Angel Gabriel told Mary that she would be the Mother of Jesus
- the Visitation – Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth who was the Mother of John the Baptist
- the birth of Jesus
- the visit of the Shepherds
- the Hail Mary Prayer.

MUSIC

We are looking at music representing fireworks.

As musicians, we are learning about:

- using our voices to sing with a range of dynamics and pitches
- exploring some of the elements of music
- listening to a range of music about fireworks, such as 'Music for The Royal Fireworks' by G.F. Handel and 'Feu D'artifice' by Stravinsky
- performing Christmas music such as Jingle bells and songs for our Christmas Liturgy.

ART and D.T.

We are looking at colours and colour mixing.

As artists, we are learning about:

- naming primary colours
- exploring colour mixing
- secondary colours
- how to create a print in the style of Clarice Cliff.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION

We are looking at dance and football.

As dancers we are learning about:

- moving our bodies in time to the music
- dancing with control
- travelling in different directions.

As footballers we are learning about:

- stopping the ball
- dribbling
- passing.



GEOGRAPHY

We are looking at our school, our local area and weather patterns.

As geographers, we are learning about:

- the key features of our school
- aerial photographs
- using simple compass directions
- drawing key features on a map
- weather patterns in the UK.

RSHE

We are looking at Online Safety, anti-bullying, community and how we are all special.

As children of God, we are learning about:

- how to use devices safely
- how to help our neighbours in the world
- how we can stop and report bullying
- how we are all unique and special
- what we are proud of.

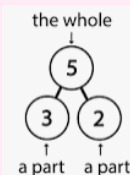


MATHS

We are looking at addition and subtraction.

- fact families, such as $5 + 3 = 8$, $3 + 5 = 8$, $8 - 5 = 3$, $8 - 3 = 5$.

As scientists, we are learning about:

As digital experts we are learning about:

- clicking and dragging using a mouse
