RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

- continue to explore the natural world around us and observe seasonal changes
- listen to stories about inspirational people from the past (Rosa Parks).

Our school trip to Drusillas Zoo will further embed our learning for this topic.



EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

As artists and musicians, we are learning to:

- use different materials and techniques to create art
- focus on depth and perspective when drawing and painting
- continue exploring musical instruments
- develop confidence to perform to a group
- further develop our role-play using our imagination in different roles
- sing in a group, increasingly matching pitch and follow a melody.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

As athletes, we are learning to:

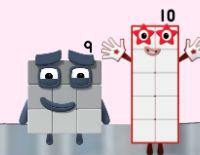
- move our bodies in time to music and beats

- explore doubles to 10
- explore odd and even numbers
- recognise and name 3D shapes
- identify complex shape patterns.
