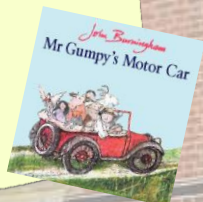


ENGLISH

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We are learning about:

- drawing information from a simple map (journeys to and from school)
- identifying local landmarks
- different means of travel and transportation
- comparing old and new vehicles
- recognising how transport has changed over time
- observing and understanding the life cycle of different plants and flowers.



EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

As artists and musicians, we are learning about:

- singing a range of well known and new songs
- exploring rhythm and beats through the use of instruments
- listening to a range of different types of music to reflect nature themes e.g. Vivaldi
- expanding our drawing skills through observation
- exploring new techniques such as collage
- using our imagination through role play.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

As athletes, we are learning about:

- Developing our hand-eye coordination through throwing, catching and balancing
- moving and hitting a ball using a racket
- hitting, bouncing and controlling a ball when moving at different speeds
- participating in athletics activities e.g. sprints, hurdles, relays.

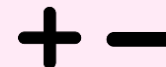
We will continue to develop our fine motor skills to secure our pencil grip and effective control of tools.

As mathematicians, we are learning about:

- building numbers beyond 10
- continuing patterns in numbers beyond 10
- verbally counting beyond 20
- adding more
- subtracting



- rotating and manipulating shapes
- explaining shape arrangements
- composing and decomposing shapes.
