

ENGLISH

We are looking at fiction texts.

As readers and writers, we will be reading 'George and the Dragon' by Chris Wormell and 'The Queen's Hat' by Steve Anthony.

We will be learning about:

- using the conjunctions 'and' and 'because'
- using the past tense and the 'ed' suffix
- use the 'un' prefix to change the meaning of words
- exploring new vocabulary including adjectives
- using capital letters for place names
- reading back our own writing and editing it.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We are looking at the theme of the Church as a community in our topic 'Dialogue and Encounter.'

As spiritual people, we are learning about:

- the local parish community
- the symbol of the cross
- the church as a worldwide community.

We are also looking at Judaism and the Torah as a guide to Jewish life.

MUSIC

We are looking at developing our singing voices, linking sound with hand symbols in traditional folk songs.

As musicians, we are learning about:

- how to use pitch with our voices and explore elementary dot notation
- understanding pitch in relation to instrument types
- singing with confidence in groups.

ART and D.T.

We are looking at designing a picnic, including baking biscuits.

As bakers, we are learning to:

- explore a variety of food products
- design our own picnic
- design, make and evaluate a biscuit.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION

We are looking at multisport.

As athletes, we are learning about:

- developing our balance and agility through a range of games
- changing direction when moving
- how to keep control when moving with equipment
- how to pass an object to a target
- moving with equipment with balance and control – kicking, dribbling, throwing, catching.



We will continue to look at athletic skills with Mr Buggy.

GEOGRAPHY

We are looking at the United Kingdom.

As Geographers, we are learning about:

- the 4 countries of the UK
- the 4 capital cities and their surrounding seas
- urban maps and labelling key human and physical features
- key features of London
- what makes the UK special.

MATHS

We are looking at place value within 100, money, fractions and time. As mathematicians, we are learning about:

Place value within 100

- counting from 50 - 100
- counting in tens to 100
- partitioning into tens and ones
- using a number line to 100
- finding one more and one less to 100

Money

- recognising coins and notes and their value
- counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- solving problems involving money

Time

- days of the week
- hours, minutes and seconds
- time to the hour and half an hour.

SCIENCE

We are looking at Earth Science and how we can be kind to our planet.

As scientists, we are learning about:

- the Earth's atmosphere and how it protects us from climate change
- the key parts of the carbon cycle
- the 6 R's and that REUSING is more important than RECYCLING
- ways to conserve water around our school
- weather changes across the four seasons and how weather is impacted by long term climate changes.

EDUCATION FOR PERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS

As children of God, we are learning about:

- recognising how we are cared for and kept safe in our families
- humans having a life cycle
- what the term 'disability awareness' means
- first aid and how we can keep ourselves safe in different environments
- Staying safe 'online'
- celebrating differences and similarities between each other

COMPUTING

We are looking at programming animations.

As digital experts, we are learning about:

- selecting different backgrounds and sprites
- joining commands together to create simple programs.
